- Load and Span Considerations** Calculate the total cable weight per unit length and select tray supports according to the manufacturer's load rating. Maintain recommended support spacing to prevent sagging or mechanical stress, especially for heavy power or data cables. Overloading can compromise both mechanical stability and ESD safety.
