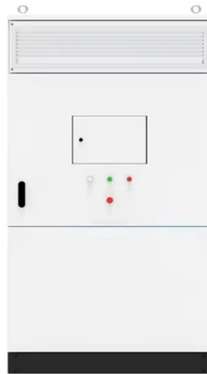


How are network rack patch cords made

A patch cord cable differs from a standard structured cabling in that a patch cable is stranded for flexibility, whereas a standard cable is solid copper. Because the patch cord is stranded copper construction the attenuation (signal loss) is higher on patch cords than solid cable so short lengths should be adhered to. They can be as short as 3 inches (76 mm), to connect stacked components or route signals through a
