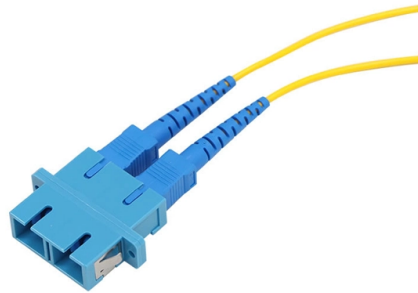


How long has the optical fiber cable line been in operation
