

How much light should a fiber distribution box normally receive

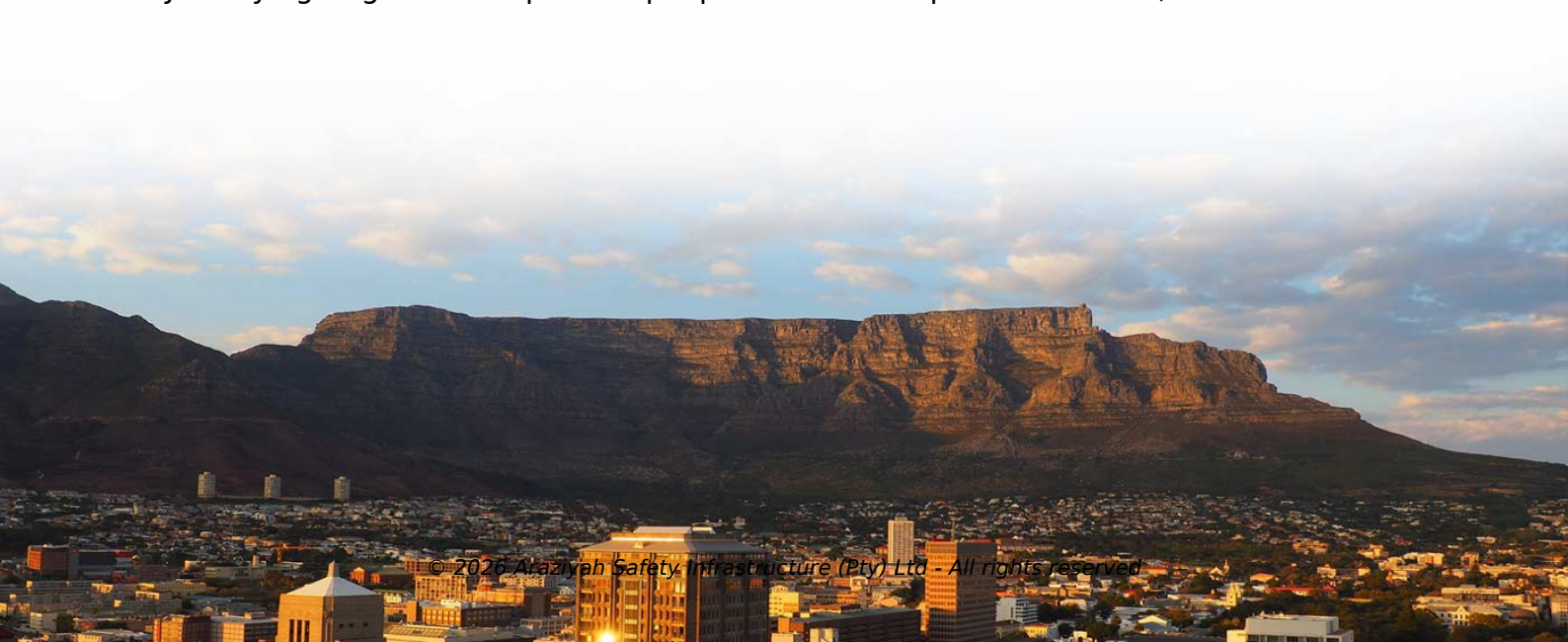


Overview
