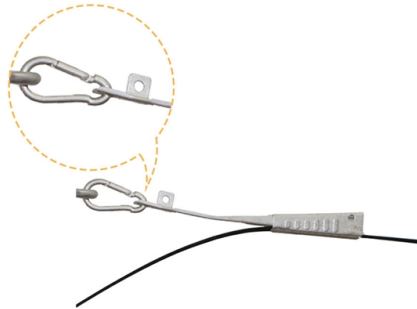


How to check the wireless network optical module



Overview

Use an optical power meter to check whether the transmit optical power of the optical module is normal. If the optical module is installed on a GE port, run the display interface GigabitEthernet x/x/x command to view port information when the optical module is inserted, including the rate and wavelength.
