Safety and Code Considerations Before attempting to hide your electrical panel, it is crucial to maintain proper clearance as required by the National Electrical Code (NEC). This includes a minimum depth of 36 inches in front of the panel, a width of at least 30 inches or the full width of the panel, and a vertical clearance of 6 feet 6 inches from the floor to any obstruction. Any covering must be non-permanent and instantly removable without tools to allow emergency access. Proper ventilation is also necessary to prevent overheating.

Popular Concealment Methods

- 1. Hinged Artwork or Mirrors** Mount a lightweight framed piece of art or mirror on butt hinges so it swings open like a door. Magnetic catches or small latches keep it flush against the wall but allow tool-less access. This method is ideal for living areas or hallways where aesthetics are important.
- 2. Custom Cabinets** Build a shallow, frameless cabinet around the panel with a door that swings open at least 90 degrees. Avoid locks to ensure instant access during emergencies. Cabinets can be painted or stained to match surrounding decor.
- 3. Decorative Screens or Panels** Use tri-fold screens, hanging fabric panels, or lightweight folding panels to hide the panel temporarily. These are easy to move and do not require permanent installation.
- 4. Recessed or Concealed Installations** For major renovations, consider recessing the panel into a wall or placing it inside a closet. This creates a flush surface and can be combined with a door or decorative cover to blend seamlessly with the room.
- 5. Furniture and Decor** Bookshelves, plants, or other furniture can be strategically placed to obscure the panel while still allowing access. Ensure that the panel remains accessible at all times.
