Ensure the module matches the required speed (1G, 10G) and cable type (Cat5e, Cat6, or Cat6a for higher speeds).

- Port Compatibility:** Not all optical ports can accept electrical modules; check the switch documentation.
- Cable Type:** Use Cat5e or Cat6 for speeds up to 1Gbps, and Cat6a or higher for 10Gbps connections.
