If you need to extend fiber to other devices or buildings, you can use fiber-to-Ethernet media converters or a fiber switch. These devices allow you to maintain electrical isolation, prevent interference, and extend the network without signal loss.

Once connected, the technician will power on the ONT and router, test the connection, and ensure full speed and signal...
