

How to connect a gigabit fiber optic cable indoors

To connect a gigabit fiber optic cable indoors, route the fiber to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), then use a high-quality Ethernet or fiber connection to your router or network devices.

Step 1: Plan the ONT Location Choose a central, accessible location for the Optical Network Terminal (ONT), ideally near a power source and your main networking hardware. This ensures efficient signal distribution and convenient access for maintenance or upgrades. Avoid areas with extreme temperatures, high foot traffic, or exposure to heat sources, as these can degrade fiber performance.

Step 2: Map the Indoor Pathway Inspect your home or office to determine the shortest and straightest path from the fiber entry point to the ONT. Use existing conduits, basements, attics, or wall cavities to minimize bends and stress on the fiber. Avoid sharp edges, abrasive surfaces, and high-traffic areas. Protect the cable with flexible low-voltage conduit if running through open spaces.

Step 3: Select the Right Fiber Cable For residential gigabit connections, single-mode fiber is standard, with pre-terminated connectors like SC/APC or LC to simplify installation. Pre-terminated cables reduce the need for field splicing and ensure polished, protected end-faces ready for direct connection to the ONT or patch panel. Indoor-rated fiber cables should be used to prevent damage from environmental factors.

Step 4: Route and Secure the Cable Use fiberglass fish tape and cable-pulling lubricant to navigate tight corners without damaging the fiber jacket. Secure the cable with soft Velcro ties instead of plastic zip ties to avoid crushing the fiber. Maintain the minimum bend radius (typically ten times the cable diameter, or at least 1.5 inches for standard indoor patch cables) to prevent signal loss from macrobends.
