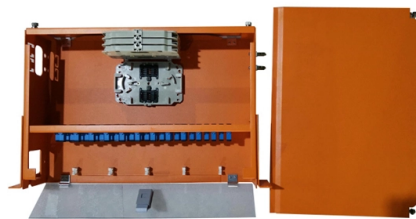


How to connect a switch during optical fiber migration

To connect a switch during optical fiber migration, use compatible SFP/SFP+ transceivers with duplex fiber cables, ensuring send and receive ports are correctly paired.

Step 4: Connect the Fiber Cable Attach the duplex fiber cable to the transceiver, ensuring send and receive ports are crossed between switches (port A on switch 1 connects to port B on switch 2, and vice versa). This ensures proper signal transmission ().

Step 5: Verify Compatibility and Bandwidth Confirm that the transceiver supports the desired network speed (1G, 10G, or higher) and that the switch firmware recognizes the module. Some switches may require configuration to enable the SFP port ().

Step 6: Cable Management and Safety For outdoor or long runs, protect fiber cables using conduits and avoid sharp bends to prevent signal loss or damage. Multi-mode fiber is generally sufficient for short distances, while single-mode is preferred for longer runs ().
