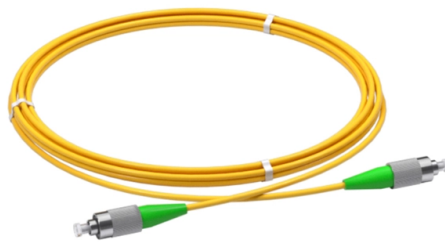


How to connect dual-fiber single-mode cables

- Distance Considerations:** Single-mode fiber supports long distances (tens of kilometers). Ensure the transceivers and cable type support your required link length.
- BiDi Alternative:** If fiber availability is limited, consider single-fiber BiDi transceivers, which use one strand for both TX and RX with paired wavelengths.
