

How to connect fiber optic cable conduits

Cable Handling and Pulling Attach the cable to a pull string using a swivel pulling eye to prevent twisting. Pull only on the strength members (e.g., Aramid yarn), never on the outer jacket or glass fibers. Use a water-based, cable-compatible lubricant to reduce friction, particularly for long runs or multiple bends. Maintain a smooth, continuous pull without exceeding the manufacturer's maximum tension (commonly around 600 lb for outdoor cables) and respect the minimum bend radius (typically 20 times the cable diameter under tension).

For complex or long pathways, consider mid-span access points to re-lubricate and manage tension.

Coiling and Unreeling Use a figure-eight pattern when uncoiling cable to prevent kinks and twists. Keep loops within recommended diameters (e.g., 5–8 ft) and avoid coiling long continuous lengths.
