

How to connect fiber optic cable to a three-network unified router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to the router's WAN port.
- Power on the router and verify that the WAN indicator light confirms a successful connection.

Step 4: Connect Multiple Ethernet Devices

- Direct connection:** Plug each of the three Ethernet cables into the router's LAN ports.
- Using a switch:** If the router has fewer LAN ports, connect one LAN port to a switch, then connect your three Ethernet cables to the switch.
- Ensure all cables are securely seated and avoid bending fiber cables beyond the recommended radius to prevent signal degradation.

Step 5: Test the Network

- Verify that each Ethernet device has internet access.
- Use network testing tools or the router's interface to check connectivity and performance.
- Adjust Quality of Service (QoS) settings if needed to prioritize traffic for critical devices.
