

How to connect fiber optic cables to an open cable management frame

- 3. Route the Fiber Cables** Use the cable management frame to guide fibers neatly. Avoid tight bends and excessive tension. Secure excess cable with Velcro straps or zip ties, keeping fibers organized and accessible for future maintenance.
- 4. Terminate or Connect Fibers** If the fibers are pre-terminated, insert the connectors into the patch panel or adapter ports. Ensure the connector clicks securely into place. If the fibers are not terminated, use epoxy-polish or mechanical splice connectors, or perform a fusion splice to join fibers to pigtails before connecting to the patch panel.
- 5. Splicing and Protection (if needed)** For ribbon or bundle cables,...
