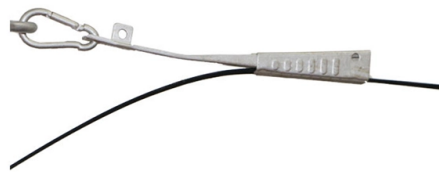


How to connect longitudinal and transverse cable trays

4. **Maintain Electrical Continuity** For metallic trays, ensure proper grounding and bonding across the connection. Use bonding jumpers if necessary to maintain electrical continuity and comply with NEC standards.
5. **Check Alignment and Load Support** Confirm that the trays are level and that the transverse tray does not introduce undue stress on the longitudinal tray. Supports should be spaced according to tray type and load, typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart.
6. **Final Inspection** Inspect all bolts, welds, and clam...
