Structured Cabling and Distribution Panels** In data centers or Fibre Channel environments, structured cabling uses distribution panels, adapters, and couplers to manage multiple fiber connections. Duplex or multi-fiber jumper cables connect devices to panels, which then route fibers to other devices. This setup allows easy expansion, maintenance, and reconfiguration while keeping fibers organized.
- 4. Topology Considerations**
 - Star topology:** All devices connect to a central hub or switch, ideal for high performance and minimal collisions. Each fiber strand can carry a dedicated channel.
 - Daisy chain or loop topology:** Devices are connected sequentially, which can reduce cabling but may require arbitration in Fibre Channel networks to prevent collisions.
