Check Polarity and Keying MPO connectors have a key and a white dot marking the first fiber. Align the key correctly to maintain proper transmit/receive mapping. For example, 12-fiber MPOs have the key in the center, while 16-fiber MPOs have an offset key . Inspect and Clean Connectors Use a fiber inspection microscope or cleaning kit to remove dust or debris from the MPO ferrule. Clean both the patch cord and the multi-core cable ends to prevent signal loss or damage . Insert the Patch Cord Gently insert the MPO patch cord into the multi-core fiber cable port or MPO adapter. Ensure the connector clicks into place without forcing it, as misalignment can damage the fibers . Secure Strain Relief MPO patch cords include strain relief components at the tail to prevent bending or pulling. Make sure the cord is properly supported and routed to avoid sharp bend...
