Grounding Requirements Every distribution box must be grounded to prevent electrical shock and equipment damage. In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is typically used, while in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is standard. The grounding system should maintain a resistance of less than 0.1 Ohm between all system components to ensure effective dissipation of fault currents.

Connection Points

Distribution Box to Mounting Plate: Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the distribution box to the mounting plate.

Mounting Plate to Central Ground: Connect a second ground wire from the mounting plate to the facility's central grounding point.

Optional Spindle Plate Grounding: For systems with long tool cables or multiple spindles, an additional ground wire may be installed between the mounting plate and spindle plate to reduce total resistance.

Wire Sizing and Resistance Considerations For long cable runs, use a 16 mm² wire (or 6 AWG in the US) to maintain low resistance. Calculate total resistance using parallel resistance formulas if multiple grounding paths exist. For example, a 60 m tool cable with 3 mOhm/m resistance and a 16 mm² ground wire with 1.4 mOhm/m results in a total resistance of 57 mOhm, which is acceptable.

Best Practices Use high-quality copper or copper-clad steel conductors to prevent corrosion and ensure long-term reliability. Install a dedicated ground bar in the distribution box; avoid double-tapping neutrals. Test the grounding system after installation; if resistance exceeds 25 Ohms, install additional rods or conductors. Follow NEC, IEC, or local codes for grounding electrode systems, bonding, and safety compliance.
