NEC Compliance: According to NEC Article 392, cable trays must remain accessible and should not be permanently enclosed unless specific conditions are met. Metallic trays can serve as grounding conductors, and proper cable separation and fill limits must be maintained.

Practical Use: In many outdoor installations, uncovered trays are common, especially when using TC-ER cables that are sunlight-resistant and suitable for direct exposure. Covers are typically added for sensitive cables (fiber optic, data) or where additional protection is desired.
