

How to design a server rack without cable management racks

Labeling and Identification Label each cable clearly at both ends using tags or colored tape. This simplifies troubleshooting and prevents accidental disconnections. Consider numbering cables or using color codes for different functions (e.g., red for power, blue for network).

Airflow and Cooling Proper airflow is critical. Avoid running cables across ventilation areas or in front of fans. Keep cables along the sides or back to allow cool air to circulate through the rack and prevent hotspots. Grouping cables neatly also reduces heat accumulation.
