Or it could be caused by the quality of the connector itself, such as poor end-face geometry that doesn't pass the. Fiber optic joints or terminations - where cables are terminated - are made two ways: 1) connectors that mate two fibers to create a temporary joint and/or connect the fiber to a piece of network gear (left) or 2) splices which create a permanent joint between the two fibers (right).
