

How to ground a factory electrical distribution box

3. Connect the Distribution Box to the Mounting Plate: Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the distribution box housing to the mounting plate. Ensure the connection is secure and corrosion-resistant.
4. Bond the Mounting Plate to the Factory Ground: Connect a second grounding wire from the mounting plate to the facility's central grounding point. The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm for optimal safety.
5. Bond All Metallic Components: Bond all metal enclosures, raceways, and equipment grounding conductors into a continuous system. This ensures that all metallic parts are at the same potential, reducing the risk of dangerous voltage differences.
6. Verify Grounding Electrode System Compliance: Follow NEC Article 250 requirements in the US, which include connecting all available electrodes and sizing the grounding electrode conductor according to NEC Table 250.66. Equipment grounding conductors should be sized according to NEC Table 250.122, based on the overcurrent protective device rating.
7. Test Ground Resistance: Measure the resistance of the grounding system. It should be w...
