Grounding and Earthing Ensure the earth bar is properly connected and tight. Measure earth path resistance to confirm compliance with standards. Check that all metallic parts are properly grounded.

Functional and Safety Tests Test insulation resistance between phases and between phases and earth. Confirm isolation and locking mechanisms function correctly. Verify heaters, if installed, are correctly mounted and insulation resistance is within limits. Check socket outlets and auto-lock mechanisms for proper operation.

Housekeeping and Compliance Ensure cables are not overlapping or exposed, and welding cables are raised to prevent tripping hazards. Maintain cleanliness around t...
