Use cable ties to secure fibers at necessary points, ensuring they are not over-tightened. Maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer to avoid signal loss or fiber damage.

Termination and Connection Strip the cable jacket carefully and clean fiber ends with lint-free wipes and alcohol. Terminate fibers using appropriate connectors (SC, LC, or ST) or splice them in splice trays. Patch panels inside the box can provide...
