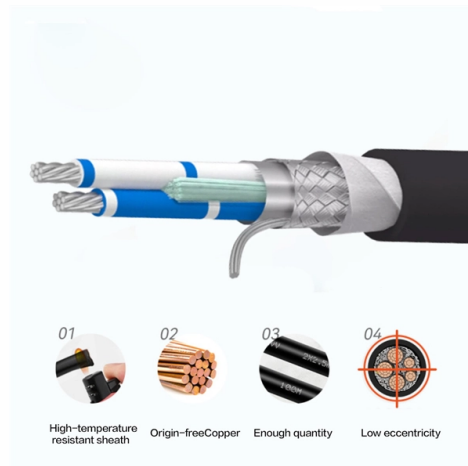


How to label cables inside cable trays

These labels should be placed on both side rails of all cable tray segments, with spacing not exceeding 15 meters (50 feet) for low-voltage or communication systems.
