

How to lay a 1000-meter fiber optic cable

Cable Installation Methods

- 1. Cable Pulling** Use tractor mechanisms, swivels, and cable grips to pull the cable through the conduit. Apply silicone-based lubricants compatible with the cable jacket to reduce friction. Monitor tension carefully to prevent damage to the fiber core. Pull from the strength member or breakaway pulling eye, never the fiber itself.
- 2. Cable Blowing (Preferred for Long Distances)** Use compressed air to blow the cable through microducts, reducing friction and tension. A tractor mechanism initially pushes the cable a few hundred meters, then air keeps it floating inside the duct. Cable stiffness affects performance: stiffer cables are better for straight runs, while flexible cables handle bends more effectively. Perform a crash test to determine maximum pushing force and prevent buckling or sheath damage. Maintain a duct fill ratio (DFR) of 35–65% for optimal blowing performance.

Safety Considerations Wear eye protection to prevent injury from glass shards or laser exposure. Keep the work area clean and dispose of fiber scraps properly. Follow FOA...
