

How to lay cables in a vertical shaft cable tray

Use listed and approved cable ties or clamps, avoiding overtightening to prevent insulation damage. For outdoor or high-temperature environments, UV-resistant or heat-rated ties are recommended .

Handling Cable Weight: Consider the gravitational load of the cable. Use pulling grips, socks, or steel wires to distribute tension evenly. For long vertical shafts, multiple synchronized cable pushers or a secondary safety wire may be necessary to prevent uncontrolled descent (Cableizer) .

Bend Radius and Routing: Maintain the minimum bending radius specified by the cable manufacturer to avoid mechanical stress. Plan the cable path to minimize sharp bends and ensure smooth transitions at tray joints or equipment entry points .
