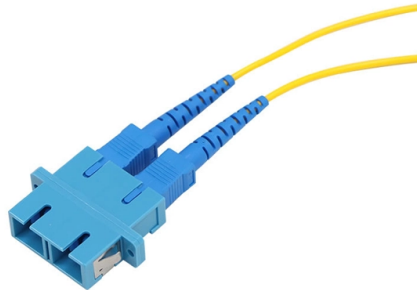


How to secure the optical cable internally
