Ensure Safety: Before changing modes, verify that the system can tolerate temporary relay inactivity. For critical circuits, coordinate with system operators to avoid unintended outages.

Access the Mode Selector:

- Electromechanical Relays:** Use the physical rotary switch or toggle on the relay panel.
- Numerical Relays:** Navigate through the digital menu using the front panel buttons or software interface to select the desired mode.

Select the Desired Mode: Rotate the switch or choose the mode in the software interface. Confirm the selection via indicator lights, display messages, or status LEDs.

Verify Mode Change: Check the relay's status indicators or software readout to ensure the relay is in the intended mode. For test or maintenance modes, confirm that the trip output is disa...
