

How to use an 8-port fiber optic switch

Step 3: Plan the Network Topology Decide on a topology based on your network needs: Star topology: All devices connect to a central switch, ideal for high performance and minimal collisions. Daisy chain or cascade: Switches are connected sequentially, but it is recommended not to exceed four layers to maintain performance.

Step 4: Connect the Fiber Cables Insert the SFP/SFP+ transceivers into the switch ports. Connect the fiber optic cables to the transceivers, ensuring TX and RX alignment. Use LC-LC couplers if connecting pre-terminated cables or patch panels. For multiple switches, repeat the process for each switch according to the chosen topology.

Step 5: Configure the Switch After physical connections: Use the switch's management tools (e.g., AXIS IP Utility or Device Manager) to assign IP addresses, configure VLANs, QoS, and port security. Verify link status and ensure all ports are active and transmitting data.
