Redundancy and High Availability Considerations Core switches often implement HSRP (Hot Standby Router Protocol) or VRRP (Virtual Router Redundancy Protocol) to provide gateway redundancy. Accessing the switch may involve connecting to the virtual IP address rather than a physical interface, ensuring continuity if one core switch fails.

Best Practices Use dedicated management VLANs to isolate administrative traffic from user data traffic. Ensure proper routing and VRF configuration for remote access, especially when using HTTP/HTTPS. Prefer SSH over HTTP for secure command-line access.
