Install Protective Devices: Connect the phase output from the RCCB to the input terminals of the MCBs. Connect the neutral wires of each circuit to the neutral bus bar. Ensure each MCB corresponds to a specific subcircuit (e.g., lighting, sockets, air conditioning).

Connect Earth Wires: All earth wires from subcircuits should be connected to the earth bus bar to ensure proper grounding.

Label Circuits: Clearly label each MCB to indicate which area or appliance it controls. This helps in troubleshooting and maintenance.

Check Wire Ratings: Use wires of appropriate gauge for each circuit based on load requirements. Ensure insulation is intact and connections are tight. T...
