Step 4: Distribute Power to Equipment Inside the rack, the PDU distributes power to multiple outlets. Connect each device to the PDU using the appropriate power cords. For dual-corded devices, connect each cord to a separate PDU to maintain redundancy. Avoid daisy-chaining PDUs or overloading outlets.

Step 5: Cable Management and Safety Route power cables to avoid blocking airflow and maintain proper cooling. Use cable organizers or vertical/horizontal managers to keep cables tidy. Leave adequate...
