Cable Laying and Organization Lay cables neatly, separating by voltage and function, and use cable ties or straps to maintain organization. Leave slack for expansion, movement, or future adjustments. Maintain segregation of power and signal cables to minimize electromagnetic interference. Ground and bond metal trays to ensure electrical safety and compliance.

Inspection and Documentation After installation, perform a walkthrough to check for loose clamps, misalignment, or overfilled sections. Label all cables clearly and maintain updated documentation for...
