Wiring Steps

Power Disconnection: Ensure the utility supply is disconnected at the meter base before starting any work.

Main Bonding: Install the main bonding screw or strap to connect the neutral bus bar to the panel chassis, establishing a single point for neutral and ground integration.

Connect Service Conductors: Route the incoming hot wires to the main MCB lugs, the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar, and the grounding electrode conductor to the grounding bus bar.

RCCB Connection: Connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB. The RCCB output then feeds the branch MCBs.

Branch Circuit Wiring: Connect each branch circuit's hot wire to the respective MCB, neutral wire to the neutral bus bar, and ground wire to the earth b...
