Hazardous Area Classification Before installation, the hazardous area must be classified according to zones: Zone 1 / Zone 2: Areas with flammable gases or vapors Zone 21 / Zone 22: Areas with combustible dust Class I / Class II, Division 1: North American equivalents The enclosure must match the zone classification to ensure safety and compliance. Protection Ratings Distribution boxes should have high IP/NEMA ratings to resist dust, water, and temporary submersion: IP66/IP67: Dust-tight and protected against heavy rain or temporary submersion NEMA 4X / 7 / 9: Common in North America for explosion-proof and corrosion-resistant applications Installatio...
