For walls with studs, center the box between studs if possible to allow secure attachment and proper cable routing. For masonry or concrete surfaces, mark the mounting holes and use appropriate anchors such as concrete screws or plastic expanding anchors.

**Conduit and Cable Considerations**

Plan the cable entry points to align with the wiring path and knockouts on the box. For multiple boxes, use painter's tape or chalk lines to visualize spacing and ensure level alignment before drilling.

**Maintain proper wire fill capacity inside the box to prevent overcrowding and ensure safety.**
