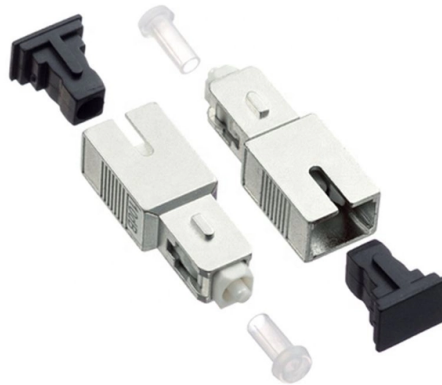


Installation method for cable tray elbow joints

Proper installation of cable tray elbows requires secure support at both ends, correct alignment, and adherence to manufacturer and NEMA VE 2 guidelines to ensure safety and structural integrity. Bonding and Grounding All cable tray systems, including elbows, must be bonded together with bonding jumpers to maintain electrical continuity. Grounding should be installed at expansion joints and at both ends of the tray system, ensuring compliance with local electrical codes. Load and Safety Considerations Verify that the tray and elbow can support the total cable weight without sagging. Maximum support spacing and load capacity should follow manufacturer specifications. Avoid placing connectors at the center of spans or directly on supports to prevent stress points. Ensure installation is performed by qualified personnel familiar with the electrical code and safety procedures.
