Hot aisle/cold aisle considerations: Power cables are typically routed in the cold aisle close to the floor, while data cables are routed just below the raised floor in the hot aisle to maintain horizontal and vertical separation. Tray height and depth: ANSI/TIA/EIA-942 recommends a maximum tray depth of 150mm (6 inches). If more capacity is needed, multiple layers or cantilever systems should be used. Load and Expansion Planning Load capacity: Ensure trays are rated for the total weight of current and future cables. Overloading can cause deformation or failure. Future growth: Reserve capacity for additional cables and plan expansion pathways. Trays should support dynamic environments where cables are frequently added or rerouted. Cable Separation and Interference Power vs. data cables: Maintain separation to minimize electromagnetic interference. Use separate trays or dedicated sections within trays for different cable types. Voltage and grounding: Metallic trays must be...
