Use cable clamps, separators, or dividers to organize cables and prevent overcrowding. For sensitive instrumentation or control cables, consider using trays with solid bottoms or covers to protect against electromagnetic interference and physical damage.
- 5. Compliance and Safety:** Vertical installations must comply with relevant standards such as BS EN 61537 for cable tray systems and local electrical...
