

Installation of electrical cable trays

Ensure supports are level and firmly anchored to walls, ceilings, or floors. For long runs, consider using cable tray rollers to prevent kinks during cable installation.

Step 5: Assemble and Connect Trays Align trays carefully and connect sections using couplers and fittings. Handle materials carefully to avoid coating damage, especially for galvanized or stainless steel trays. Install bends, tees, or risers as needed, following the marked route.

Step 6: Lay and Secure Cables Once trays are installed, route cables neatly within the tray, maintaining proper spacing and fill ratios (usually max 50% of tray capacity). Use cable ties or clamps to secure cables...
