

Installation of fiber optic splitter for home access

Measure and Strip Fiber: Cut the fiber optic cables to the required length. Strip approximately 5mm of the fiber jacket using a wire stripper or fiber cleaver.

Clean the Fibers: Use alcohol wipes or a fiber cleaning pen to remove dust and debris from the exposed fiber ends. Cleanliness is critical to prevent signal loss.

Connect or Splice: For splitters with connectors, plug the input fiber into the splitter's input port and connect output fibers to devices or distribution points. Secure connectors with clips or screws. For bare splitters, use a fusion splicer or mechanical splice kit to join fibers carefully, avoiding bending or breaking the fiber.

Mount the Splitter: Place the splitter inside a fiber distribution box or protective enclosure. Coil any excess fiber to maintain proper bend radius ($\geq 5\text{cm}$) and prevent damage.

Testing: Use an optical power meter to measure input and output power. Ensure insertion loss is within the theoretical range (e.g., 3.5dB for a 1:2 split). Check uniformity between output ports and troubleshoot if necessary.
