

Installing a distribution box on the relay wall

- Grounding:** Connect the PE (protective earth) bar to the foundation steel or wall grounding system using copper wire. Ensure all cabinet doors are connected with braided copper wires and spring washers to prevent loosening.
- Busbar Connection:** Fasten busbars with the appropriate wrench and apply neutral Vaseline to contact surfaces. Maintain proper spacing from other devices to avoid short circuits.
- Circuit Wiring:** Install circuit breakers according to load requirements. Connect line, neutral, and ground conductors to their respective terminals, following color coding standards. Use cable ties and strain relief to organize wiring neatly and prevent conductor stress.
