Poor grounding can lead to electric shock or equipment damage. Grounding should never rely solely on contact with the earth; it must follow local electrical codes and standards. In-Ground Installation Exceptions Certain PVC junction boxes can be installed in the ground if they are listed for burial, covered with gravel or non-cohesive soil, and remain fully accessible for maintenance. However, they should never be placed in heavily trafficked areas, and the cover must remain exposed. This is more common for underground cable junctions rather than standard distribution...
