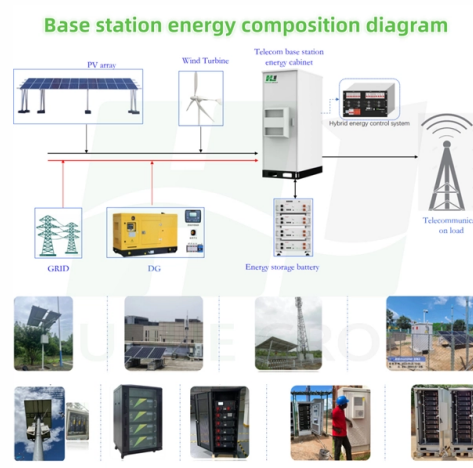


Japan to Brunei optical cable fault

The South-East Asia Japan Cable (SJC) connects Japan and Brunei among other Asian countries, but no current fault has been reported in the available sources. Overview of the SJC System The South-East Asia Japan Cable (SJC) is an 8,900 km submarine cable system (planned extension to 9,700 km) linking Japan, Brunei, Mainland China, Hong Kong, Singapore, the Philippines, and Thailand . It consists of 6 fiber pairs with an initial design capacity of 28 Tbps, using advanced SLTE and OADM branching technologies to optimize data transmission . The system became operational on June 27, 2013, and is supplied by NEC and TE SubCom with a total investment of around US\$400 million . Connectivity Between Japan and Brunei The SJC provides a direct optical link between Japan and Brunei, ensuring high-speed internet and telecommunications connectivity. This link is critical for regional data traffic, business communications, and international internet access. The cable's design allows for redundancy and high reliability, but like all submarine cables, it is susceptible to physical damage from anchors, natural events, or technical faults. Cable Faults and Maintenance Submarine cables occasionally experience faults, which can lead to slower internet speeds or temporary outages. Repairs typically involve specialized cable ships and coordination with local authorities for permits to access the cable site . While historical incidents in the region, such as SEA-ME-WE 3 and 4, have caused significant disruptions, there is no current report of a fault affecting the Japan-Brunei segment of the SJC in the sources provided . Key Considerations The SJC system is state-of-the-art, supporting upgrades to higher capacities as demand grows . Any fault along the cable would likely trigger rerouting of traffic through alternative cables to maintain connectivity. Monitoring and maintenance are ongoing to minimize downtime and ensure stable internet service across the connected countries .
