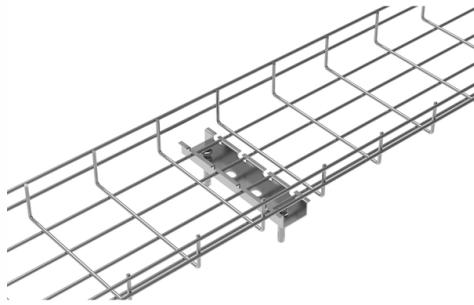


Meter markings on the outer sheath of optical cables
