- 4. Accessories and Fittings:** Horizontal and vertical bends, T-pieces, crossovers, and end closures are fixed using bolts, clamps, or integrated mounting plates to maintain continuity and secure cable routing.

Best Practices

- Maintain minimum bend radius for cables to prevent damage.
- Ensure even load distribution and avoid overloading trays.
- Use corrosion-resistant materials (galvanized steel, stainless steel, or aluminum) depending on environmental conditions.
- Follow IEC 61537 or relevant national standards for mechanical strength, spacing, and installation.
