

Mobile fiber optic cable entering the router

A fiber optic cable cannot connect directly to a standard router; it requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the light signal into an electrical signal your router can use. Why an ONT is Necessary Fiber optic internet transmits data as light pulses, which standard routers cannot interpret directly. The ONT serves as a bridge, converting the optical signal from the fiber into an electrical signal compatible with your router via an Ethernet cable. Some ISPs provide combo units that integrate the ONT and router, but in most setups, the ONT is a separate device. Router: Must support Ethernet WAN input; fiber-ready routers can maximize speed. Ethernet cable: Cat6 or higher is recommended to maintain gigabit speeds. Power supply: For both the ONT and router. Step-by-Step Connection Install the ONT: Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize. Connect ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the Router: Wait for the router's indicator lights to confirm a successful connection. Configure Wi-Fi settings as needed. Optional Mesh Setup: For larger homes, mesh devices can extend Wi-Fi coverage while still using the ONT as the main fiber interface. Key Considerations Direct connection to a standard router is not possible because routers cannot process optical signals without conversion. Proper handling of fiber connectors is crucial; avoid touching the glass tip to prevent signal loss. High-quality Ethernet cables ensure you maintain the full speed potential of your fiber connection. FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home) setups provide the best performance, as the fiber runs directly...
