If it shows 0.0.0.0, the router is not receiving a valid IP from the ISP, which could be due to a modem/router misconfiguration or MAC address restriction. Possible fixes include: Restarting the modem and router in the correct order Cloning your computer's MAC address to the router Changing the router's LAN IP range if it conflicts with the modem Firmware and Software Updates Ensure your router and ONT are running the latest firmware to avoid compatibility issues. Older routers may require updates or replacement if they cannot handle the fiber connection properly. ISP and Service Checks Confirm there is no outage in your area by checking your ISP's service status page or app. Some ISPs lock internet access to a specific device; contacting your ISP may be necessary if the router is not recogniz...
