Practical Example For a small GPON deployment serving 12 subscribers, a single Fiber Optic Box MAB could suffice, storing up to 60 splices or terminating 12 fibers. In larger enterprise or metro networks, multiple boxes are installed at distribution points, with each box handling a portion of the total fiber count to maintain organization and minimize signal loss.

Proper planning ensures optimal performance, minimal signal loss, and ease of maintenance.
